Qualifications

- Must be a student resident of Putnam County and plan on attending an Ohio College or University in the fall of 2021.
- Applicants shall be deemed more qualified if they have displayed leadership qualities in youth organizations, community activities, and agriculture related activities, although this is not mandatory.
- It is preferred but not mandatory that applicants declare a major in some aspect of Agriculture and have an agricultural background with a realistic business plan to enter the Ag industry.
- The recipient must be a full-time student and maintain a minimum of a 2.0 accumulative grade point average and accepted to an accredited two- or four-year College or University (attach a copy of acceptance).
- The Selection Committee will consist of the Putnam County Cattlemen’s Association Scholarship Committee. The winner will be announced mid-March of 2021.

Timeline

- Application deadline is **February 28, 2021**
- The winner will be notified in mid to late March. The 2021 Cattlemen’s Banquet has been cancelled due to Covid-19 concerns.
- Monies to be awarded after completion of 1st quarter/semester of college.
