In 2024, one \$500 nonrenewable scholarship will be awarded. This scholarship is sponsored by the family of Jeff Kleman.

Qualifications

- Must be a resident of Putnam County and plan on attending an Ohio College or University in the fall of 2024.
- Applicants shall be deemed more qualified if they have displayed leadership qualities in youth organizations, community activities, and agricultural related activities, although this is not mandatory.
- It is preferred but not mandatory that applicants declare a major in some aspect of agriculture and have an agricultural background.
- The recipient must be a full-time student and maintain a minimum of a 2.5 cumulative grade point average and accepted into an accredited two- or four-year college or university.

Timeline

- Application deadline is March 22, 2024
- Recipient will be announced by April 19, 2024
- Money will be awarded after completion of the first quarter/ semester of college.

Application Procedure

Return completed application to your High School Counselor or submit applications directly to Gary Herman, Curriculum Coordinator, Putnam County Educational Service Center no later than **4:00 p.m. on March 22, 2024. The application must be received by March 22, 2024**, and not just postmarked.
