Last Thursday, Lauryn Auchmuty scored her 1,000th career point in a game versus Leipsic. Lauryn is seventh Lady Bulldog to reach the 1000-point threshold in school history. She is also just the second Lady Bulldog to score 1,000 points before the end of her junior year. The other player to achieve this feat was her cousin, Jade Clement, whose Lady Bulldog basketball career spanned from 2014-2017. District Operations for April 8, 2024 Finalized

Earlier this month, I mentioned that district operations would likely change for Monday, April 8, the date we will experience a total solar eclipse. At this past Monday evening's Board of Education meeting, those plans were finalized. Columbus Grove Schools will NOT be in session on Monday, April 8. Staff will still report for work on this day and professional development activities. Many schools in the region are following suite, as the uncertainty of what to expect in terms of visitors in our region and the time of the eclipse (right at school dismissal) would create significant disruption to school operations for this day. Update on School Delays and Closings

As we enter the heart of winter, we have used one calamity day so far for the 2023-24 school year (January 16). We have five calamity days in total to use before we begin making these days up. As we did last year, if we reach a sixth calamity day or beyond this school year, we will first refer to the Board approved 2023-24 school calendar and to see if there are any scheduled days remaining which are designated to make-up for in person instruction. These pre-scheduled make-up days for in person instruction are February 20 (Presidents Day) and March 22 (Third quarter break). If we reach a sixth calamity day after these dates, we will make these days up via virtual school days of instruction, with students completing their instruction and assignments online.

One of the biggest benefits of using this approach is that it will eliminate school days getting added to the end of the school year, during a time when families have vacations already planned. Hopefully, we will not get to a sixth calamity day or beyond this school year, but we wanted to make you aware of this process in the event it occurs.
