Stadium Lighting Project Approved by Board of Education

The Columbus Grove Board of Education recently approved the installation of a new lighting system at Clymer Stadium, with the project beginning later this spring and having a projected completion date of August 1. The current lighting system is over 25 years old and has been showing its age with an increased number of repairs needed over the last few years. The new system will be an LED lighting system that will be installed by Musco Lighting, a company with an excellent reputation in this field. This LED lighting system at Clymer Stadium will provide benefits to players, as they will be better able to track the entire flight of the ball as compared to the current lighting system. Additionally, this new lighting system will be better for neighbors, as the directional light of the LED system will minimize the glare of an older traditional lighting system. We look forward to utilizing this new system this August when we open the 2024 football season versus Pandora-Gilboa!

2023-24 School Closings Update

As of last Friday, we now have used three calamity days for the 2023-24 school year, leaving us with two more school closings before having to make up additional calamity days. As we did last year, if we reach a sixth calamity day or beyond this school year, we will first refer to the Board approved 2023-24 school calendar and to see if there are any scheduled days remaining which are designated to make-up for in person instruction. These pre-scheduled make-up days for in person instruction are February 19 (Presidents Day) and March 22 (Third quarter break). If we reach a sixth calamity day after these dates, we will make these days up via virtual school days of instruction, with students completing their instruction and assignments online.

One of the biggest benefits of using this approach is that it will eliminate school days getting added to the end of the school year, during a time when families have vacations already planned. Hopefully, we will not get to a sixth calamity day or beyond this school year, but we wanted to make you aware of this process in the event it occurs. 2024-2025 Kindergarten Registration Now Open

Kindergarten registration for the 2024-2025 school year is now open. If your child will turn 5 years old prior to September 30, 2024, they are eligible for kindergarten. You can register on our website (cg.noacsc.org) by clicking the link in the Parents/Student/Community tab or you may contact the school at 419-695-2631 and we will walk you through the registration process. At the beginning of March, a letter will be sent informing you of your date and time for screening. The dates for screening will be in April 11 and 12. Documents needed are a birth certificate, immunization records and/or Kindergarten boosters, parent ID, proof of residency (if new to the district and no other siblings attend CG schools) and custody papers if applicable.
