At the beginning of March, a letter was sent informing you of your date and time for screening. The dates for screening will be April 11 and 12. Documents needed are a birth certificate, immunization records and/or Kindergarten boosters, parent ID, proof of residency (if new to the district and no other siblings attend CG schools) and custody papers if applicable.
