Upcoming Road Construction to Impact Busing Schedules

Beginning April 10, the county will begin work on West Sycamore Street at the corner of State Route 65. This work will take place on the west side of SR65, and it includes widening the road to create a left turn lane, as well as the elimination of a pedestrian crosswalk on the south side of the West Sycamore (including sidewalk on the south side of the bridge) at SR65. After the road construction is complete, pedestrians will only be able to cross SR65 on the north side of West Sycamore Street.

Due to this construction, there will be a fair amount of changes regarding bus schedules, as buses dropping off students at St. Anthony's will have to accommodate for both a different drop-off location at St. Anthony's and an alternate route to the elementary and high school. This change in routing may move up your child's bus pick-up time a few minutes in the morning. Your bus driver will be in contact with you if your bus pick-up time changes. For the p.m. routes, buses that typically go out of town on West Sycamore Street will have to re-route as well, which means afternoon drop off times will be impacted. Again, your child's bus driver will be in contact with you if their bus route is impacted.

In addition to this road construction on West Sycamore Street, the village will begin road repairs on East Sycamore Street in mid-April. This construction will impact bus routes on the east side of the district. Families of riders impacted will be contacted by their bus drivers in order to make adjustments to these routes as well.

While there will likely be some minor issues in the implementation of new morning pick-up times, our drivers will work diligently to get new procedures streamlined as soon as possible. Substitute Bus Drivers Wanted

Columbus Grove Local Schools is accepting applications for substitute bus drivers. This position has the potential of becoming a full-time bus driver in the future, if the applicant is interested. Substitute bus drivers are contacted to drive extracurricular and field trips and occasionally drive a regular morning or afternoon route. Certification requires the completion of attending a pre-service class, a written and driving test, CDL license, a medical physical exam, drug test, BMV check of driving record, and a background check. Cost for training will be fully reimbursed by the district for any individuals who serve as a substitute bus driver for Columbus Grove Local Schools.
