At the April Board of Education meeting, it was announced that the district would have a 1:00 p.m. early dismissal on Thursday, May 25, the last day of school for students. This year's commencement will take place on Sunday, May 21, in the high school gym at 2:00 p.m. It will also be livestreamed as well, allowing family and friends who cannot make the commencement in person to watch it on their electronic device. # Attention Parents: Food Service Point of Sale System Changing

For the last 15 years we have been using Meals Plus in our cafeteria for our point of sale system. Meals Plus was recently acquired by another company, LINQ, and as part of that acquisition the Meals Plus product is being phased out. Knowing that we would have to make a transition to a new product, we explored a few options for going forward and we are happy to announce we have selected PaySchools; a Canton, Ohio based company, for our next point of sale system.

The transition to the new system will take place this Monday, May 1. Remind messages/communications regarding this change were sent out to parents over the last week. Your students should see no changes when they go through the line - they will use their same PINs, and they can still bring checks or cash in to add money to their accounts. All of their current balances will transfer over to the new system as well.

There will be a couple of changes to the online portion of the system for those of you that have used that in the past. There is a new online portal which you can register for

here: <u>https://www.payschoolscentral.com/</u>. This will be the one-stop location to check student balances, set up alerts, see transaction history, transfer money between students, or deposit money via a credit card or bank account. Please note: like before, depositing money online does incur a nominal fee.

One feature that was not available with the new systems we evaluated was the "Family Account" which allowed all students grouped together as a family to pull from the same pool of money. When we transition to PaySchools, money that is currently in a Meals Plus family account will be split evenly between the students when the balance is transferred.

In addition, parents can soon apply for free and reduced lunches directly in the online portal for the 23-24 school year. Verification and status determination will be done immediately upon submission. # Does my student need to know any new numbers?

No, the student PINs will all stay the same - the process of going through the lunch line will be exactly the same as it is now.

# Where do I go to check my student balance? Sign up for an account at

https://www.payschoolcentral.com or use the

PaySchool Central app on your smartphone to connect to your student accounts, check balances, sign up for reminders, and more.

# Will we still get Remind alerts about our balance if we signed up for those?

Balance alerts will no longer go out through Remind. All balance alerts will be generated by the new system at <u>https://www.payschooolscentral.com</u>. Just sign up there and you can manage which alerts you'd like to receive.

# Why can't we use a family account anymore?

All of the systems we evaluated did not have this functionality. On the plus side, however, the online management of your student accounts is much easier and allows you to transfer money between students.

# Can I still send one check or cash payment for all of my students since I can't use a family account?

You can still send one check or amount of cash, just write on the check memo line or envelope that you'd like to split the amount between accounts. You can also use the online system to transfer money between your students.

- The area Council of Churches is sponsoring the Baccalaureate Service for all graduating seniors on Sunday, May 21, 2023 at 12:30 p.m. in the high school gymnasium. All seniors will be receiving an invitation in the mail. Please RSVP to the church, or in the high school office.
- Seniors should clean their lockers out by Friday, May 12. Seniors will not be released from class to clean out their lockers. Seniors still needing to attend to their lockers will be asked to take care of this after graduation rehearsal on Friday, May 19.
