The Columbus Grove baseball team won its first district title since 1982 last Friday with a thrilling 4-3 victory over the McComb Panthers at Marathon Field in Findlay. Senior ace Shep Halker went the distance in the contest, withstanding a McComb comeback attempt in the top of the seventh inning. With the victory, the Bulldogs tied a school record in number of wins in a season (23). The Bulldogs will attempt to break this school record tonight at 5:00 p.m. when they play Delphos St. John's in the regional semi-final in Elida. Did You Know?

With last Friday's District Championship, this year's baseball squad tied a school record in number of wins in a season with 23. The only other squad to win 23 games in a season was 1972 squad coached by Bruce Rasor. Here's a look at the baseball teams in school history that have reached the 20-win mark in a season, along with the Head Coach of each squad (* denotes winning a district championship that season as well):

- 23 wins: 1972 (Head Coach Bruce Razor) and 2023* (Head Coach Brayden Sautter)
- 22 wins: 1976* (Head Coach Gary Jones)
- 20 wins: 1982* (Head Coach Mike Lamb) and 2013 (Head Coach Cory King)

Substitute Bus Drivers Wanted for the 2023-2024 School Year

Columbus Grove Local Schools is accepting applications for substitute bus drivers. This position has the potential of becoming a full-time bus driver in the future, if the applicant is interested. Substitute bus drivers are contacted to drive extracurricular and field trips and occasionally drive a regular morning or afternoon route. Certification requires the completion of attending a pre-service class, a written and driving test, CDL license, a medical physical exam, drug test, BMV check of driving record, and a background check. Cost for training will be fully reimbursed by the district for any individuals who serve as a substitute bus driver for Columbus Grove Local Schools.
