Road Construction Begins Today

The state will begin work on the road widening project at State Route 65 and West Sycamore Street intersection. This work will result in adding left-hand turn lanes on State Route 65. The traffic light at this intersection will be moved to the intersection of West Street and State Route 65 to help manage traffic.

Morning bus schedules will need to adjust slightly to take into account traffic delays due to this construction. Some bus drivers will have to adjust their routes for the afternoon as well, causing a change in drop-off times. Your child's bus driver will contact you if your child's bus route is impacted.

Student and Parent Drivers: Please give yourselves extra time in the morning on your commute to school as new traffic patterns and procedures are established to accommodate this new road construction. ATTENTION PARENTS OF WALKERS WHO CROSS STATE ROUTE 65

As was done during the previous road construction project, CG Schools will provide transportation for walkers who cross State Route 65. Morning pick-up will be at St. Anthony's on Bus #8 (Driver is Linda Ridenour). Student walkers must arrive at St.

Anthony's no later than 7:30 a.m. Mrs. Fuerst will be at St. Anthony's to assist students as we establish this new procedure. A bus designated for the afternoon drop-off will be available in the bus line at school. This bus will drop off walkers at approximately 3:10 p.m. behind St. Anthony's School.

Any in-town student riders who take advantage of this transport must have a completed emergency medical form for the bus driver. These emergency medical forms will be distributed tomorrow to these students. Parents, please complete these forms for your child to give to the bus driver by **tomorrow**, **September 13**.

Advance planning to coordinate the parade participants has begun. To make this process as safe and smooth as possible, several guidelines have been set for all participants to follow.

- Floats arrive at the American Legion parking lot before 4:45 p.m.
- There will be a parade coordinator stationed at the entrance to the American Legion who will direct floats to their designated location.

- Beginning at 4:45 p.m., Plum Street will be blocked off at the intersection with the alley. The traffic will be one way at Plum Street and moving towards the American Legion. Parents with children are asked to enter at Plum Street and drop their children off at the alley intersection before exiting down the alley.
- If children are too small to walk the distance to the American Legion by themselves, a student council representative will be available to walk with them.
