Many CrossFit-affiliated gyms, military members, veterans, and civilians participate in the "Murph" every year to honor those who made the ultimate sacrifice for our nation. This workout consists of a mile run, 300 air squats, 200 push-ups, 100 pull-ups, and concludes with another mile run.

Tonight, the players will have their team meal at the VFW with the color guard. Tomorrow night's game will include guests from the Ohio National Guard. The Bulldogs will play in their special military jerseys, with the name of a veteran they are honoring on the back nameplate of their jersey. Many thanks go to the Columbus Grove the VFW who purchased these special camouflage jerseys for our football team!

Public Address Announcer Nick Gilgenbach will read every player's name on our roster, along with the name of the veteran he is honoring on the back of his jersey.
