## CGHS Student Success Leads to Another Busy Upcoming Weekend!

In last week's update, I highlighted the many activities taking place with our students competing in various activities. This weekend continues to be a busy one, as CGHS students continue to excel on the fields of competition. Here's a quick recap:

- Girls' Soccer- The girls' soccer squad topped a challenging Mansfield Christian squad 5-2 in the district semifinals at Bluffton this past Monday evening and then they faced off against Bluffton Thursday night at Bluffton's Steinmetz Field. The Lady Dogs beat Bluffton 4-2 securing a District Title for the first time in the team's history! The girls travel to Port Clinton on Tuesday to compete against Evergreen in the Regional semifinal game at 6:00 p.m. Good luck ladies!
- Football- The Bulldogs held off a tough LCC squad last weekend at Clymer Stadium by a score of 28-20. This puts the Bulldogs' record at 9-0 as they head into their final regular season game versus Bluffton tomorrow night. This will be a battle of unbeatens, with the winner taking the NWC title outright. Game time is 7 p.m. at Harmon Field.
- Girls' Cross Country The girls' XC team punched their ticket to regionals last Saturday with an impressive runner-up performance at the district meet. The following runners ran a personal best in the race on their home course: Lily Montgomery- 20:22 (now 11<sup>th</sup> on the girls' XC record board), Grace Morman- 21:02, Lauren Martz- 21:12, Claire Koch- 22:03, Dakota Dunn- 23:05, and Breanne Fuerst- 23:32. The girls will compete at regionals this Saturday at 10:45 a.m. at Tiffin.

- Boys' Cross Country Last Saturday, boys' cross team won the district for the seventh year in a row. In what took last year's team 11 years to break the 5-man fastest team time record, it took this year's team only 366 days. The 5-man team combined to run an 83:00, surpassing last year's 83:03. That is an average time of 16:36. Levi Bryan, who finished 2nd in the 144 runner race, became only the 6th runner in Columbus Grove's storied history to break the 16 minute mark, crossing the line in 15:55, a 23 second PR. Senior Bryce Bonifas set a personal record by 20 seconds, finishing 9th in 16:38. Aidan Voigt broke into the 16's in a big way, finishing 11th in 16:43, a 22 second PR. Zack Bryan was 15th overall, PR'ing by 32 seconds and running an amazing 16:46. Holden Hartzog gave the Dogs five guys under 17:00, with a 19th place finish in 16:56, 32 second PR. Braylon Best also had a PR by 8 seconds, running a 17:09 and finishing 23rd. Caiden Squillante came back from illness and finished a respectable 17:49. The Bulldogs will compete this Saturday at 10:00 a.m. in Tiffin as well.
- Marching Band- Last Saturday evening, the Bulldog Marching Band competed at the Maumee Band Invitational, coming away with a coveted Superior rating, marking the fourth year in a row of qualifying for state competition! By punching their ticket to the State OMEA Finals, the Bulldog Marching Band will compete this Sunday at 4:30 p.m. at Piqua High School, attempting to earn their second consecutive Superior rating at the state competition.

### School Income Tax Renewal Levy on the Ballot November 5

On November 5, Columbus Grove Schools will have a 3/4% RENEWAL (ZERO increase tax rate) on the ballot. This levy, which was first passed in 1996 has been renewed on a five-year basis since and is up for another five-year renewal this November. This levy constitutes approximately 15% of the district's operating budget. With the tenuous nature of public-school funding from the state, this levy is critical to our district's operations in meeting the needs of our community's students.
