The following evening, CG traveled back to Bluffton's Harmon Field and put together a dominating 42-0 victory over a previously unbeaten 9-0 Bluffton Pirates squad, winning the school's sixth NWC Championship in the last seven years. The Bulldogs will face North Baltimore tomorrow evening at Clymer Stadium in the first round of the OHSAA Football Playoffs.

The next morning, both of our Cross-Country teams headed to Tiffin to compete in the OHSAA Regional Race. Our ladies ended their season with a very respectable 11th place finish. This is the second consecutive years our ladies qualified for regionals and we are confident that this team will be back to compete for state qualification next year. Congratulations, ladies and Coaches Jay and Martz!

The boys XC team put together another solid performance winning their second consecutive OHSAA Regional Title! This was no small feat, considering the challenging field of teams at regionals this year. The defending state champions will run at the OHSAA State Cross Country Meet this Saturday at Fortress-Obetz in Columbus. Race time is 10:00 a.m. Best of Luck to our boys and Coach Schnipke!

On Sunday, our CG Marching Band competed at the OMEA State Band Competition Finals at Piqua High School. - Girls' XC team- The girls' cross-country team closed their 2024 season last Saturday with a strong finish at the Division 3 Regional meet. Leading the way were Sarah Kamphaus, 33rd and Lily Montgomery, 34th running their person records of 20:08 and 20:10. Lauren Martz finished 84th in 21:27, Grace Morman was 131st in 22:33, and Claire Koch was 132nd in 22:34. Dakota Dunn finished in 23:15 and Breanne Fuerst finished with a personal record of 23:19.
- CG Football Dominance- With last week's 42-0 win over the Bluffton Pirates, the Columbus Grove Bulldogs have taken the school lead for most NWC football titles all-time, with 17. They surpassed Delphos Jefferson at 16 while Bluffton stands at 14 all-time NWC football titles. The 2024 NWC title is the Bulldogs' sixth in seven years. Not surprisingly, many Bulldogs made the NWC All-Conference team this year, including a clean sweep in Offensive Player of the Year (Trenton Barraza), Defensive Player of the Year (Kylan Mayes), and Coach of the Year (Andy Schafer).
