Qualifications

- Must be a resident of Putnam County and plan on attending an Ohio College or University in the fall of 2025.
- Applicants shall be deemed more qualified if they have displayed leadership qualities in youth organizations, community activities, and agricultural related activities, although this is not mandatory.
- It is preferred but not mandatory that applicants declare a major in some aspect of agriculture and have an agricultural background.
- The recipient must be a full-time student and maintain a minimum of a 2.5 cumulative grade point average and accepted into an accredited two- or four-year college or university.

Timeline

- Application deadline is March 21, 2025
- Recipient will be announced by April 22, 2025
- Money will be awarded after completion of the first quarter/ semester of college.
