• Must be the son, daughter, brother, sister, grandson or granddaughter of a veteran (active duty or honorable discharge) who served in one of the following United States Armed Services Branches: Army, Air Force, Navy, Marines, National Guard or Coast Guard.

• Must be accepted as a full time student in an accredited college, university, or technical school.
