Qualifications

- Must be a student resident of Putnam County and plan on attending a 2-year or 4-year Ohio college or university in the fall of 2025.
- To be awarded on the basis of the student's character, values, service and motivation as demonstrated by their church participation, community activities or volunteerism. High school records, participation, and leadership roles in extra-curricular activities, and work history will be evaluated but are not the core focus for this award.
- Preference will be given to a student entering a field of study focusing on a social service field, including but not limited to social work, teaching, psychology, and other service-related fields.

Timeline:

- Application deadline is April 4, 2025 at 4:00 p.m.
- Recipient to be announced by April 22, 2025
- Monies to be awarded after completion of 1st quarter/semester of college
