Qualifications

- The scholarships will be awarded to 2025 graduating students who are committed to not only bettering themselves, but also their community.
- The student must show a strong interest in giving back to their team/group/community, etc.
- The student must plan to attend a trade school, technical school, two- or four-year college or university in the fall of 2025. **Special consideration will be given to students who are pursuing trade-related careers.** Examples include cosmetology, welding, massage therapy, HVAC, CDL and other certificate programs.
- No minimum GPA is required and encourage all graduating students to apply.

- Recipient(s) to be announced by April 22, 2025.
